



ALUMNI Feedback Report

2023-24

The Alumni Feedback Form for the academic year 2023-24 was circulated to gather insights on alumni perceptions, memories of college life, and suggestions for improvement. The form included questions on alumni details, their views on networking initiatives, and recommendations for enhancing the alumni-college connection.

Key Highlights:

1. Demographics of Respondents:

- The majority of responses (over 60%) were from the 2023-24 batch.
- Students from **B.Com (H)** and **B.Sc (H)** streams formed the bulk of the respondents, with an almost equal split between them.

2. Satisfaction with Alumni Engagement:

- Over **65% of respondents** expressed satisfaction with the college's efforts to maintain a connection with its alumni.
- Nearly all respondents (around **97%**) are members of the alumni WhatsApp group, indicating strong informal networking.
- However, only **15%** of respondents have registered on the **ALMA SHINE portal** (the official alumni portal for SGGSCC), highlighting a need for increased awareness or promotion of the platform.

3. Willingness to Contribute:

- Alumni showed eagerness to contribute towards the college's welfare, especially through mentorship programs, helping students with placements, internships, academic research, guest lectures, and knowledge partnerships.
- Among these, **mentorship programs** emerged as the most preferred mode of contribution.

4. Overall College Ratings:

- The college received **excellent ratings** from the majority of respondents across various aspects, including:
 - **Teaching and Learning Experience**
 - **Growth Opportunities for Students**

□ **Extracurricular Activities** ○ The **infrastructure** and **extracurricular activities** were particularly highlighted as "outstanding" by a significant number of alumni.


5. Memories of College Life:

- Many respondents also reflected on their personal growth, attributing it to active participation in college societies and the exposure to SGGSCC's diverse cultural environment.

6. Overall Experience and Suggestions:

- Over **65% of alumni** rated their overall college experience as **outstanding** or **very good**.
- The most common suggestion was to **increase placement opportunities for Computer Science students**, reflecting a need for focused career support in this field.

This report underscores the college's successful efforts in fostering a meaningful relationship with its alumni while highlighting areas for improvement, such as enhancing placement support and promoting the alumni portal. Alumni feedback continues to serve as a valuable resource in shaping SGGSCC's ongoing development.



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
