
Parents Feedback Form Analysis (2019-2020)


The feedback form for the academic year 2019-2020 received an overwhelming response. Out of the responses so received, nearly 39% accounted for those parents whose wards are enrolled in B.Com (Hons). The relevant percentages for B.Com, B.A. Eco (Hons), B. Sc Computer Science, BMS and post-graduation courses were 44%, 5%, 7.5%, 4% and 1.5% respectively.

Do you believe that the college and its environment has transformed the personality of your ward?




Nearly 36% of the parents view the infrastructure of the college to be outstanding and a near about similar percentage view it to be very good.


