Cyber Security for Students: Keep yourself out of traps

The session started with the introduction of topic by Dr Sangeeta Dodrajka, Coordinator, IQAC, SGGSCC followed by words of inspiration delivered by Principal Sir. Then Dr Sunaina Kanojia was introduced and thereafter she started with description and further elaborating the topic with some incidents like BOYS LOCKER ROOM, Shabana's case and one Keylogger incident. She also discussed the article by The Department of Telecommunications regarding free internet data rumour. She answered a big question, "Why do we need to protect data?". She also acquainted the students about RBI protection Policy and suggested some measures for ensuring 'Cyber Hygiene' like don't store the card details and CVV number in the system, don't use free networks for financial transactions, don't upload pics with locations on real time basis and many more.

The Webinar was followed by a Question-Answer round where participants asked their queries, which were answered by Dr. Sunaina Kanojia in detail. The response and feedback received from participants during the session was overwhelming. The session was enlightening and an enriching experience.
