About the Symposium

Rapid exponential advancement in technology and communication has led to Industrial Revolution 4.0 where man and machine align to enable new possibilities. It has revolutionised industries and transformed the society so much that work that exists today will not exist in next decade. Thus, one needs to use the best practices of both specialties to get and maintain high educational standards in this rapid changing world.

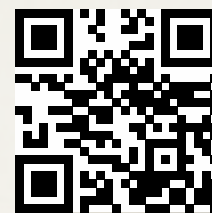
