Initiating the plans into action, the Club has successfully started project "Udaan 2.0", a literacy program for poor and underprivileged kids. The Club plans to further expand this plan to allow these kids to have the future they want. Further climbing the ladder to make change the Club organized its Flagship Project-Annual Blood Donation Camp at Sri Guru Gobind Singh College of Commerce. The camp was held with the primary purpose to collect blood for patients with thalassemia and to help alleviate the blood scarcity in blood banks. The initiative of trying to address the dearth of blood by donating for the welfare of society. The Club was successful in collecting 226 units of blood.

The Club has not only focussed on humans but also on the welfare of the voiceless, by tying radium bands to almost 100+ dogs to protect them even in the dark. PROJECT UDAAN

Udaan 2.0 is a continuation of the Udaan initiative headed by the Rotaract Club of Sri Guru Gobind Singh College of Commerce, aimed at providing education to underprivileged children in our district. Firmly believing in the transformative power of education, Club views it as a means to shatter barriers and instill hope in the lives of slum children.

Udaan 2.0 is a weekly project in which a dedicated team of Rotractors visits the district park, driven by the goal of imparting knowledge while fostering an atmosphere of enjoyment for the children. Subjects such as mathematics, Hindi, and English are taught alongside engaging activities like singing, festive celebrations, and games. Through this interaction, a profound bond is forged between the Rotractors and the students, enriching both parties.

Ensuring the students are able to understand and grasp the lessons, rotractors diligently monitor the students progress and check their homework regularly. Witnessing the growth and development of these students is truly heartening and reaffirms the significance of their efforts in making a positive impact on their lives.





HIFAZAT- SELF DEFENCE WORKSHOPS

Hifazat an initiative led by the Rotaract Club, is dedicated to educating individuals on self-defense and safety. Recognizing the paramount importance of self-protection, our team of Rotaractors organised engaging sessions to teach children fundamental techniques such as punching, kicking, and palm heel strikes. Additionally, vital rescue techniques were imparted to empower individuals to effectively safeguard themselves in the face of potential assaults.

In collaboration with the Ujjwal Education Centre, led by Rtr. Jasnoor, a brown belt, we organized a drive to further our mission. Students were instructed in the basics of self-defense and punching techniques, fostering their confidence and preparedness for difficult situations. Moreover, we incorporated fun activities like dodgeball, providing a dynamic way for them to learn how to react and protect themselves in challenging situations.

"Hifazat" serves as a pivotal project, equipping individuals with the indispensable skills necessary for personal protection and fostering a culture of resilience and empowerment.
