Workshop on Graphic Designing

As the tech society of the college we take pride in our digital posters and designs that we put out on our social media platforms. To ensure we maintain the high quality of work we are known for we decided to organise a workshop for all members of the tech-team in our society. The aim of the workshop was to familiarise the members of the society with the tools used to make the posters and for internal development of the society in the graphics designing field. Due to the members' engaged participation the workshop was a success.

Graphista(Event) - A Graphic Designing Competition

Recently we organised Graphista, our graphic design competition. The event saw over 400 registrations, from 50+ colleges all across the country including institutions like IIM Rohtak, IIM Amritsar and DTU. The participants sent in their designs and after careful consideration, the results were announced .The top 3 participants were given prizes for their creations. Partnership with WAGMI (Mudrex)

In this session, WAGMI, a student-led community, was also a partner.
